

Keep It Practical

This activity will allow members to:

- Start thinking about the details of a service project.
- Collaborate as a team.
- Think through problems to find solutions.

Materials needed:

- One printed worksheet per member. Download it at kkids.org/IDEA.
- Pens or pencils

How to lead this activity:

Come together as a club to learn how you can create a high-impact service project!

1. Give each member a Keep It Practical worksheet.
2. Ask members to form groups. Here's how:
 - a. Using numbers 1–4, assign each member a number.
 - b. Or, ask members to count off 1–4.
3. Ask each group to read the questions together—and then have each member write his/her own answers on their worksheets.
4. When everyone is finished, ask for volunteers to stand up and share their answers. Thank each member who shares with the club.
5. When the activity is over, thank everyone for their time and participation.
