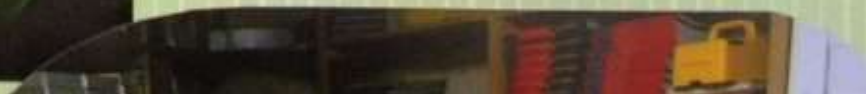

Bowling Green K-Kids Celebrate the Holidays through Service

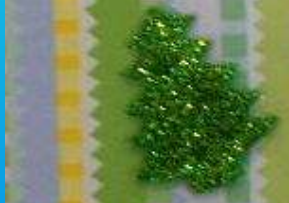
