## REFLECT AND EVALUATE TO WRAP UP

The end of the year is a perfect time to help members process their K-Kids club experiences. For reflection and evaluation, lead members through the following quick activities using the [K-Kids Member Guide](#):

2. **Page 11:** Have members answer the questions in "Reflecting on Your Year" to help determine what they learned and what they want to do differently next year.
3. **Pages 12-13:** If your club used the calendar to record service hours, ask members to add up their hours and congratulate them on their big action to make their world better.
