

## K-Kids Faculty Advisor Council 2025-26

**The Council's purpose:** To provide Kiwanis Youth Programs with the unique perspectives of faculty advisors about K-Kids resources, program support, and what advisors and clubs need.

**Term for members:** August 2025 – May 2026; renewable for a total of up to three years.

## The Council's work for 2025-26 will be to share thoughts and feedback on:

- 1. The *K-Kids Advisor Guide, K-Kids Member Guide, K-Kids Service Guide*, Officer guides and Committee Chair guide.
- 2. K-Kids website resources (including meeting kits, newsletters, digital resources).
- 3. K-Kids awards and contests.

## **Council members' commitment:**

- 1. Attend three of four virtual meetings (to be held in late September, November, January, and early April).
- 2. Review materials and documents and provide feedback when asked, sometimes prior to a meeting.

**How to apply:** Complete the online application form at <u>https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/kkids-faculty-advisor-council-application</u> between April 1 and May 31, 2025.

## Requirements to be a council member:

- 1. Applicant must be a current K-Kids faculty advisor with two or more years in this position, including 2024-25. A *faculty advisor* is a teacher, counselor, staff member or other adult appointed by the host school/organization to serve as the club's advisor.
- 2. Applicant <u>must have used or had their club use</u> activities or instructions for at least two of the following resources: *K-Kids Advisor Guide, K-Kids Member Guide, K-Kids Service Guide* several times in a year. Use of the Officer Guides and Committee Chair guide is also helpful.
- 3. The K-Kids club must be in good standing. This means the club is active and its renewal fees have been paid for the current year.

**Benefits for serving on the Faculty Advisor Council**: We will provide a letter for professional development points/hours that outlines the hours of service you provided on the council and list of work you accomplished. We will also send you K-Kids swag!
