



## K-Kids Faculty Advisor Council 2026-27

**The Council's purpose:** To provide Kiwanis Youth Programs with the unique perspectives of faculty advisors about K-Kids resources, program support, and what advisors and clubs need.

**Term for members:** September 2026 – May 2027; renewable for a total of up to three years.

**The Council's work for 2026-27 will be to share thoughts and feedback on various topics. In early September, members will receive an email containing the list of topics we will discuss before the first meeting of the year.**

**Council members' commitment:**

1. Attend three of four virtual meetings (to be held in mid-late September, November, January, and early April).
2. Review materials and documents and provide feedback when asked, sometimes prior to a meeting.

**How to apply:** Complete the online application form at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/kkids-faculty-advisor-council-application> between April 1 and May 31, 2026. *Members of the 2025-26 council do not need to re-apply to remain on the council in the upcoming year.*

**Requirements to be a council member:**

1. Applicant must be a current K-Kids faculty advisor with two or more years in this position. A *faculty advisor* is a teacher, counselor, staff member or other adult appointed by the host school/organization to serve as the club's advisor.
2. Applicants must be familiar with and have used [K-Kids resources and meeting kits](#) available on the [kkids.org](http://kkids.org) website.
3. The K-Kids club must be in good standing. This means the club is active and its renewal fees have been paid for the current year.

**Benefits for serving on the Faculty Advisor Council:** We will provide a letter for professional development points/hours that outlines the hours of service you provided on the council and list of work you accomplished. We will also send you K-Kids swag!
