HOW TO COSPONSOR A K-KIDS CLUB

A Kiwanis club can make the K-Kids experience amazing — by cosponsoring a K-Kids club with another Kiwanis family club. Working together, those clubs can provide more service and leadership opportunities for K-Kids members. That collaboration also ensures that a Kiwanis family volunteer can attend and help with K-Kids meetings.

What does the cosponsor relationship look like?

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OFFICERS BUILD KIWANIS CONNECTIONS

Being a K-Kids officer means leading. That leadership includes a responsibility for making connections with people outside the club. For a K-Kids club president or vice president — or all officers — what better leadership experience than to talk about their club's impact in front of Kiwanians? Work with your sponsoring Kiwanis club to determine at least one time per year for your officers to present updates at Kiwanis club meetings. It's a great way to build officers' skills — and their club's connection with the Kiwanians who support them!
