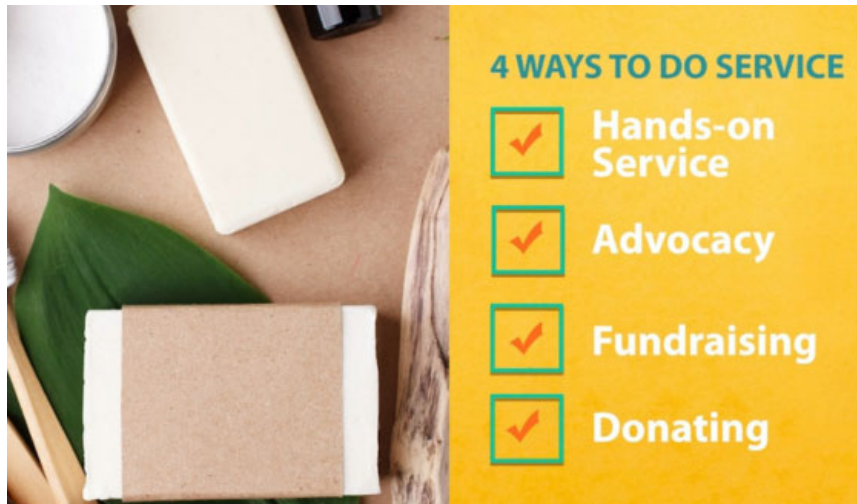
District administrator chat video is available!
